1. The plaintiff claims:

2. The defendant is the owner of an animal that attacked and severely injured the

plaintiff at an address at the Sandy Bay First Nation in Manitoba on August 13, 2020.

3. The defendant had a strict duty to control their animal to prevent harm to persons

and property, in which duty they failed as alleged in the preceding paragraph.

PARTICULARS OF DAMAGE

4. In the said attack, the plaintiff was bitten in the left shoulder and leg and partially

devoured by the animal causing permanent physical injury, scarring and nervous shock.

After the attack, the plaintiffs bone, ligaments and adipose tissue were exposed and pieces

of her flesh were left on the ground. The injuries were so severe that the plaintiff required

in patient hospital care for approximately one month and reconstructive surgery to graft

skin over the areas of the injury. She has been partially disabled in her capacity to walk

and required and will require ongoing physio and occupational therapy to restore her body

and health in the future.
